-Renew your rental every semester. When the year is over, you must return the instrument, with no return on your investment.

-No long term commitment. Return anytime.

-No upgrade option is available. The instrument you get is what we have.

-We will cover routine maintenance **up to the amount of your rental**. Belzer does not have the ability to replace a lost, or stolen instrument.

-We rarely have extra instruments for students to use when their instrument is being repaired. But, we do our best.

-Purchase of a Belzer Instrument is not an option.

Belzer Middle School has several instruments ranging from violin to bass for rent. Many families rent through the school rental program because they believe it is cheaper. The school rents ALL of its string instruments for \$50.00 per semester or \$100.00 per year. Broken up for the school year, that equals roughly \$10.00 per month. **Paige's Music rents a violin for \$25.00 per month but covers all of the items above on the list AND your \$25.00 goes towards the eventual purchase or**

upgrade of your instrument. With a Belzer instrument rental, you will need to return the instrument at the end of each year AND get no return on your investment. In addition, if you are an 8th grader and plan to continue playing in orchestra at LC next year, you might consider starting to make the investment now. LC is **VERY** limited in how many school instruments it has available and may not be able to provide you with what you need.
